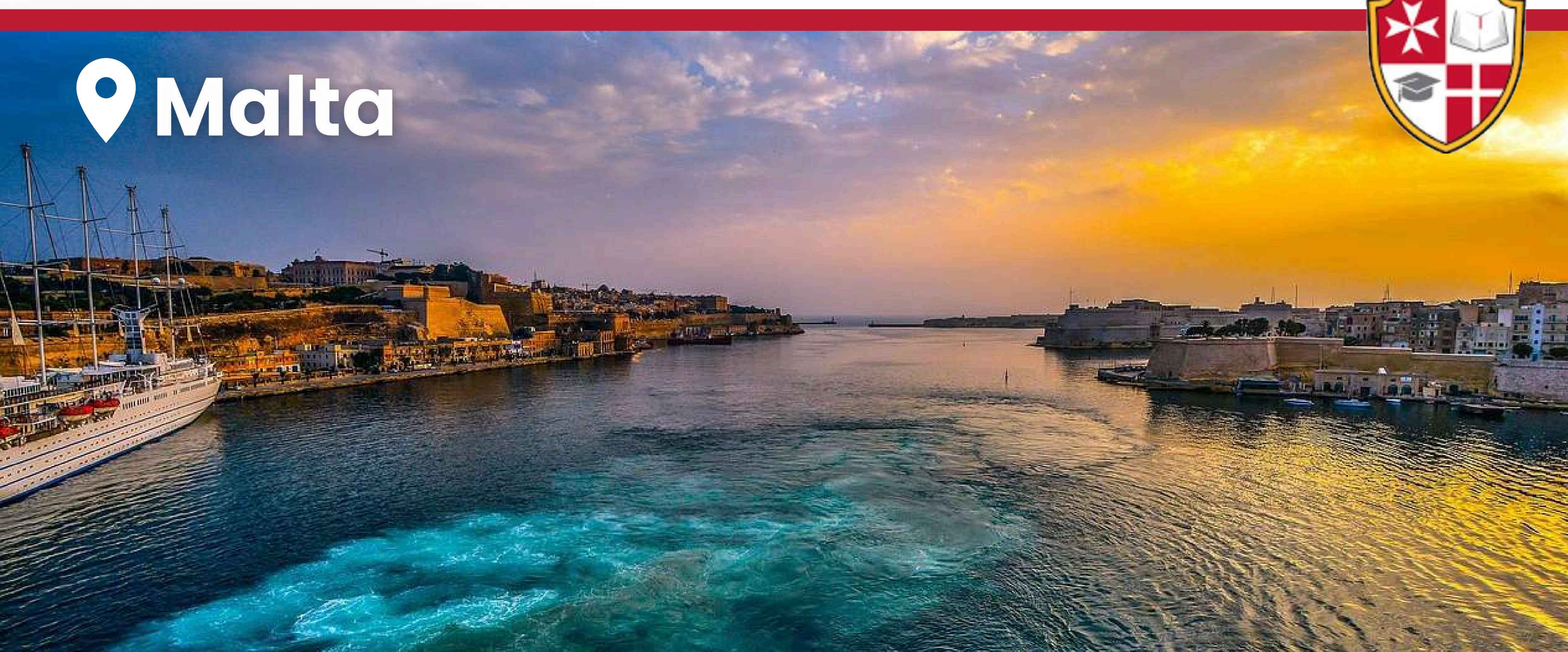

Prospective Vistula University students who **do not hold a recognized B2 English certificate** are conditionally admitted to Vistula University and can study **“Award in English Proficiency + Academic Certificate”** program in **Malta** for a minimum of **36 weeks (3 semesters)** up to 1 year to get their certificate and continue their studies at Vistula University in Poland.



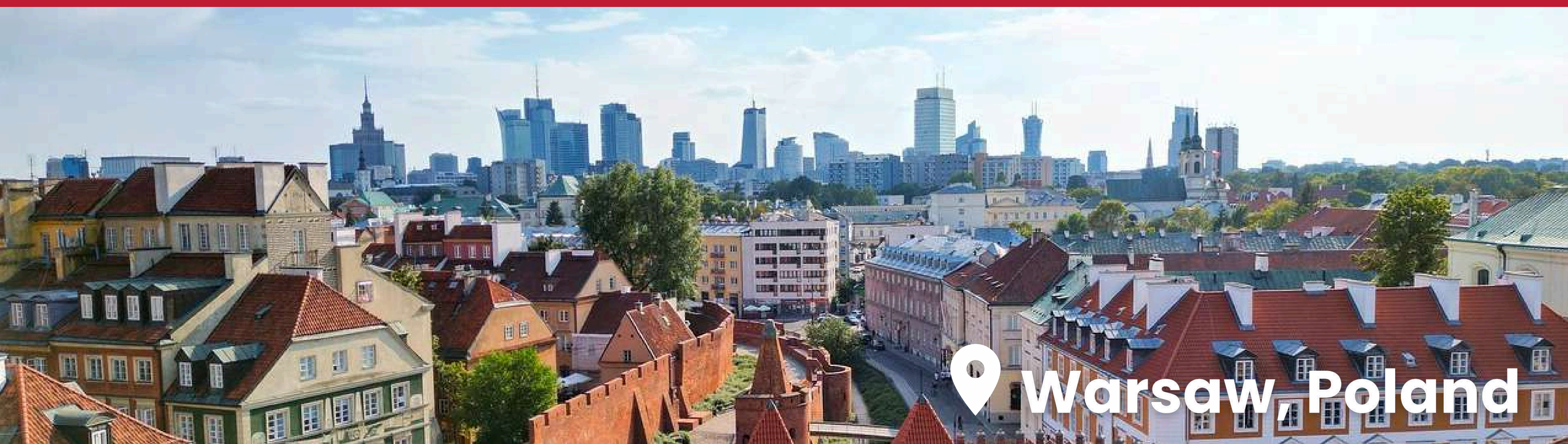

APPLICATION PROCESS:



- ★ This program is for students who need to **improve their English** proficiency to **B2 level** so that they can start their first year courses.
- ★ The students, like all others, will **apply to Vistula University** and receive conditional admission.
- ★ They can submit their applications through Dream Apply and provide the required documents by Vistula.
- ★ The condition is to **attend Award in English Proficiency & Academic Certificate program in Malta** and reach **B2** Level.
- ★ **Vistula** gives the students a **Letter of Acceptance**
- ★ Students will sign **Study Contracts with Vistula** and make **all payments to Vistula**.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

FOR THIS PROGRAM



High School **Diploma** for undergraduate candidates

★ GPA over **60%**

English – at least **elementary level (A1)**

Conditional entry to Vistula University on **2nd or 3rd semester**

★ based on successful completion of the **Award in English Proficiency + Academic Certificate program** at B2 level and ECTS courses if taken.



30 ECTS earned in Malta leads to the admission **on the 2nd semester of BA in Management** in Vistula University



60 ECTS earned in Malta leads to the admission **on the 3rd semester of BA in Management** in Vistula University.



VISA PROCESS



- ★ Students will **apply for a National D Visa** through the relevant Malta VFS office in their home country (or a neighbouring country, should a VFS office not be available locally).
- ★ Visas will be issued with a **validity of 91 days**, after which students will be required to **apply for a Temporary Residence Card (TRC)** covering the remainder of their study.
- ★ Applications must be submitted **no later than 12 weeks** before the official start date of the programme.
- ★ List of required documents for visa applications are **provided by CVU of Malta**
- ★ **All criteria** outlined in the updated documentation checklist **must be fully met**, including valid accommodation bookings and proof of sufficient funds (either personal or via a sponsor), with a minimum balance of €12,500 recommended.
- ★ Students must be prepared for a **possible visa interview**, hence a **basic level of communicative English is required**.



ACCOMMODATION

- ★ Students need to demonstrate an initial **short accommodation** on **booking.com** or similar for visa process.
- ★ The students will look for the longer accommodation options in Malta . The price for a shared room with a shared bathroom will cost **€300 - €400** per month.
- ★ Accommodation options are presented at **campushubmalta.com** or similar websites

- ★ Students will submit tuition and other associated VFS and application fees directly to Vistula University.
