SEMESTER DATES

Please note that for the academic year 2024/25, the spring semester of the 3rd year is not open. Students can still enroll for the autumn semester of the 3rd year and for both semesters of the 4th year.

3rd year program (Bachelor 3 level) = Semester 5

Semester 5: end of August – end of January Semester 6: end of January – mid June (not available)

4th year program (M1 level) = Semesters 7 and 8

Semester 7: end of August – end of December Semester 8: early January – end of March





APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Nomination

All exchange students must be nominated by the international advisor of the partner university. Nominations should be sent by e-mail to Mrs. Susan LOUBET : <u>susan.loubet@esiea.fr</u>

2. Enrollment

All students must enroll online on our Mobility Online platform. Students will receive the **application link by email.**

Application documents to upload on the ESIEA Mobility Online platform.

- ID photo in either JPG or PNG format
- Photocopy of passport or ID card
- Study transcripts in English
- Curriculum vitae
- Proof of language level (B2 required in French or English depending on your programme) *
- Learning Agreement

ACCOMMODATION

	All students must show proof of French housing insurance upon arrival to cover accidental damage caused by the tenant or by natural disasters: flooding, storm, etc
	They must also take out civil liability insurance which covers the damages you might cause to third parties. This is generally included in the housing insurance, but this needs to be checked.
	To take out a housing insurance policy, you can use any online provider, but you must use a French insurance company. Hereunder you will find two options:
