THE CAMPUS

Institut Mines-Telecom Business School's campus covers six hectares and is located 35km south of Paris.

The school shares its campus (with secured entrances/exits) with its sister engineering school, **Telecom SudParis**. It has many open spaces and offers a multitude of activities. Various facilities available to all, along with a dynamic and challenging academic environment, allow students to succeed in their studies while maintaining an excellent quality of life.

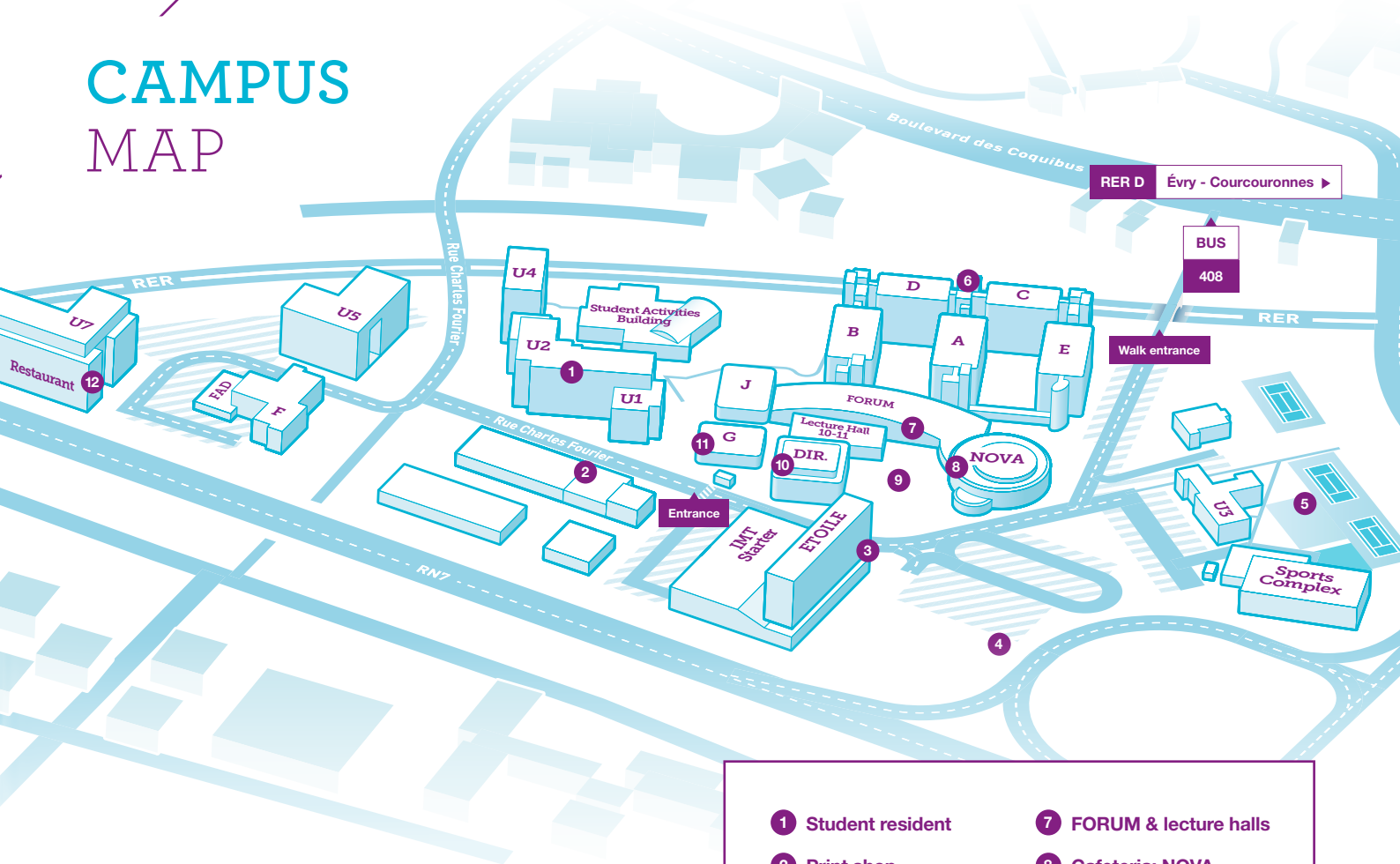

ACADEMIC PREREQUISITES

- > Current academic level
- > Minimum GPA 2,6
- > B2 level in English or French (CEFR):
 - **TOEIC:** 785 min
 - **TOEFL iBT:** 72 min
 - **IELTS:** 5,5 min
 - Or a letter of recommendation from the home university stating the recommended language level (B2)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Online Application

After being nominated by their home university, students will receive an email which will allow them to create their personal account on our application portal. They will then have to complete their application with the following documents:

- 01 / Valid ID / Passport
- 02 / ID photo
- 03 / One page letter of motivation (in English)
- 04 / Curriculum Vitae (in English)
- 05 / Academic reference (only for non-European exchange students)
- 06 / Official academic transcripts of last 2 semesters
- 07 / Certificate of language proficiency in English or French (depending on the chosen program)

ADMINISTRATIVE FORMALITIES UPON ARRIVAL

Visa	No visa requirement for European students but Non-European students must obtain a visa to enter France. Get information on France visas' website .
French Translated Birth Certificate	Please bring an original birth certificate with you before coming to France as it will be requested by French administrations such as Prefecture, Social Security, CAF, etc... This document will need to be translated into French and the translation needs to be done by an official translator. If you translate the document in your country of origin, the only accepted translations are the ones from translators located inside French Consulates or Embassies. All other translations will be rejected by French administrations. You can also get a translation in France. Here is the list of official translators . It takes between 1 and 2 weeks to get your documents translated.
Personal liability Insurance	Must be valid on campus for the whole duration of student's stay at IMT-BS
Health Insurance	<p>It is compulsory for all international students to be covered by Social Security. The CPAM (organism in charge of social security) will give you refunds on a part of your health expenses such as medical care, hospital or pharmacy for instance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">> European Students have to request a EHIC - European Health Insurance Card before leaving their country. They will get refunds for their health expenses in France from their own country.> Non-European students have to subscribe an international health insurance before coming to France at least for their first month in France. As soon as they arrive in France, they must register online by filling out the form and uploading the requested documents. <p>Note: students have to have a French bank account to be able to apply for Social Security.</p>
Bank Account	Possibility of opening an account with one of our bank partners in Evry (optional)
